Circus for All will feature international speakers, panel discussions, workshops, and a special circus performance- Kalevala. This family circus show will be performed by PiiPoo Family Circus; a Finnish organisation that specialises in circus training for families and people with disabilities.

The community circus model uses the diversity of circus arts as a way of meeting the needs of a variety of target groups in a dynamic, responsive and responsible way. Community circus programmes are tailored around participants' resources, abilities and interests and can change to fit the participant rather than asking the participant to change to fit the programme.

Circus for All and Kalevala are part of a week-long knowledge exchange and strategic partnership being developed between Galway Community Circus and Kulttuurikeskus PiiPoo. This partnership is funded by Erasmus+
